Why is Mathematics Treated Differently?

In order to learn to be a good English student, to read and understand novels, or poetry, students need to have memorised the meanings of many words. But no English student would say or think that learning about English is about the fast memorisation and fast recall of words. This is because we learn words by using them in many different situations – talking, reading, and writing. English teachers do not give students hundreds of words to memorise and then test them under timed conditions. All subjects require the memorisation of some facts, *but mathematics is the only subject in which some people believe they should be tested under timed conditions. Why do we treat mathematics in this way?*


Learning Websites


