### Learn, Create, Share and the teaching of reading at Levin North School

In the last newsletter Mr P shared the BSLA approach to learning to read which is used in our junior school. He also shared a good reader profile image which is part of the focus as our tamariki move through the school.

This week we have started work on another piece of this puzzle and this was our classroom observations; which are of course focussed on the teaching of reading.

If you haven't guessed, this is part of our current key learning focus and also part of the work we do as part of the Manajakalani Cluster mahi.

The data from our observations helps teachers in our school to look at what they are doing well and where they can improve. It also contributes to a much bigger data picture which focuses on what is happening in 150 schools across Aotearoa NZ. The focus here is also what we are ALL doing well and how we can do things better!

I have observed four teachers this week and without exception they have been quite stunning in their work! I saw all the things we value as a school AND so much more. I saw teachers:

- Celebrating each child as an individual person while they were learning
- Totally focussed on the needs of individual learners
- Ensuring kids had a GREAT time learning
- Making sure that kids kept trying and didn't give up And lastly kids helping other kids!

Our kids at North are so lucky!

We recently had interviews and the panel found it very hard to make a choice - EACH applicant (from inside our school) was stunning in their own way.
