## Maths posts

Last week we reported on your child's maths. Our goal is always to provide a visual which explains the concept that the child is working and a word from the child where it is appropriate. As you can see from the images below maths is an incredibly diverse learning area - not just 'sums' on a page. Maths is really about developing a curiosity about how the world works, exploring possibilities and finding explanations - not necessarily just finding ONE answer.

# Ask your child about their post.

This time there should also have been a statement on your child's post about where they are 'at' in terms of expectations. This is something that we are continuing to work with our provider (HERO) in our reporting processes and in 2024 this (should) will be much easier to understand across Reading, Writing and Maths. If at any time you want more information about where your child is at, please come and see the teacher. They would be more than happy to discuss progress.
